Crop Use Directions – Winter Squash

Preemergent Application

Apply to emerged annual weeds at 10 to 20 fl.oz./A after winter squash is planted but before the crop has emerged. Touchdown HiTech may be tank-mixed with residual herbicides for preemergence use. Consult the federally approved Touchdown HiTech label for approved tank mix partners and additional use directions.

Follow directions listed in the **Application and Mixing Directions**, **Spray Additives**, and **Application Equipment and Techniques** sections of the federally approved label. Refer to **Weeds Controlled** for application rates.

Precautions and Restrictions:

Do not apply if crop seeds are exposed due to poor row closure during planting.

Do not apply if radicle has emerged or the soil covering the seeds is cracking indicating crop germination.

When applying postplant, do not use on coarse soils or soils with less than 1% organic matter.
