AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS

Use this product only in accordance with its labeling and with the Worker Protection Standard, 40 CFR part 170. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply to actively growing volunteer cereals that are 2-6 inches in height. Apply *Select Max*[™] with Inside Technology[™] at a rate of 12-16 fl. oz. per acre by ground or air. By ground, use a minimum of 5 gal. and a maximum of 40 gal. spray solution per acre. By air, use 3-10 gal. spray solution per acre. Complete coverage is essential for control. Use higher water volumes and the maximum *Select Max* rate for volunteer cereal that is greater than 3-4 inches in height. A non-ionic surfactant at 0.25% v/v is recommended.

RESTRICTIONS:

1. Always read and follow all label directions when using any pesticide alone or sequentially.
2. Do not apply more than 16 fl. oz./A in a single application.
3. Do not apply more than 32 fl. oz./season.
4. If a second application is required, then allow a minimum of 14 days before treatment.
5. Mustard and arugula green manure crops treated with *Select Max* must be incorporated (e.g., tilled or disked) into the soil or allowed to winterkill.

RESISTANCE MANAGEMENT

Select Max is a Group1 herbicide. Any weed population may contain or develop plants naturally resistant to *Select Max* and other Group 1 herbicides. Weed species with acquired resistance to Group 1 may eventually dominate the weed population if Group 1 herbicides are used repeatedly in the same field or in successive years as the primary method of control for targeted species. This may result in partial or total loss of control of those species by *Select Max* or other Group 1 herbicides. Repeated use of *Select Max* (or similar postemergence grass herbicide with the same mode of action) may lead to the selection of naturally occurring biotypes that are resistant to these products in some grass species.

If poor performance occurs and cannot be attributed to adverse weather or application conditions, a resistant biotype may be present. This is most likely to occur in fields where other control strategies such as crop rotation, mechanical removal and other classes of herbicides are not used from year to year.

To delay herbicide resistance, consider:

- Avoiding the consecutive use of *Select Max* or other target site of action Group 1 herbicides that have similar target site of action, on the same weed species.
- Using tank mixtures or premixes with herbicides from different target site of action groups as long as the involved products are all registered for the same use, have different sites of action, and are both effective at the tank mix or prepack rate on the weed(s) of concern.
- Basing herbicide use on a comprehensive IPM program.
- Monitoring treated weed populations for loss of field efficacy.
- Contacting your local extension specialist, certified crop advisors, and/or manufacturer for herbicide resistance management and/or integrated weed management recommendations for specific crops and resistant weed biotypes.
