ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is extremely toxic to fish and aquatic invertebrates. Use with care when applying in areas adjacent to any body of water. APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Rate of application is variable according to pest pressure, timing of sprays, and field scouting. Use lower rates under light to moderate infestations; higher rates under heavy insect pressure and for mite control. Arid climates generally require higher rates.

Control of Spruce Spider Mites and Root Weevil

General: Apply Brigade 2EC at the rate of 3.9 to 6.4 ounces (0.06 to 0.1 lb. active) per acre. Apply in a minimum of 5 gallons of water per acre by air or in a minimum of 20 gallons of water by ground.

Crop/Site: Christmas Trees

Target Pest: Spruce spider mites and root weevil

Application Advisory: Brigade 2EC has demonstrated excellent plant safety. However, not all species and varieties have been tested. Prior to full scale application, treat a few plants for observation.

Rate: Use 3.9 to 6.4 ounces (0.06 to 0.1 lb active) per acre.

Restrictions:

Do not apply more than 6.4 ounces (0.1 lb. active) per acre per treatment.

Maintain a minimum of 21 days between Brigade 2EC treatments.

Do not make more than 3 applications in a crop year.

Do not apply more than 0.3 pound active per acre per season.
