#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For treatment of seed intended for export only. Not for use immediately before planting (such as through use of hopper boxes, planter boxes, slurry boxes, or tractor-mounted treaters), or any other uses covered by the Worker Protection Standard, 40CFR part 170.

ENHANCE<sup>®</sup> Seed Protectant helps protect grass seed against seed rot and damping-off diseases such as *Pythium* and *Rhizoctonia solani* and helps to control seedborne smut.

**DIRECTIONS:** Measuring cup enclosed (One level cup holds approximately one ounce of product.)

**GRASS SEED (For Export Only):** Apply 6.4 ounces of ENHANCE<sup>®</sup> Seed Protectant per 100 pounds of seed. This rate is equivalent to using 0.8 grams a.i. of carboxin per kilogram of grass seed, and 0.76 grams a.i. of captan per kilogram of grass seed.

For best results, pre-measure the appropriate amount of ENHANCE<sup>®</sup> Seed Protectant and an EPA-approved dye and place them in a mixing tank or other suitable device with the seed. Mix thoroughly to evenly coat the grass seed.

SEED LABELING: Treated seed must be labeled "For Export Only-Not to be sold or offered for sale in the United States."  
The U.S. Seed Act requires that treated seed be labeled with the following information:

"WARNING. This seed treated with carboxin and captan. Do not use treated seed for food, feed, or oil purposes."

Use an EPA-approved dye which imparts an unnatural color to the seed.
