GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

COMITE is a liquid emulsifiable concentrate for preparing sprays to control mites. COMITE is not systemic in action, therefore complete coverage of both upper and lower leaf surfaces and of fruit is necessary for effective control. After three-quarters full of water, add recommended dosage (from table) of COMITE to the spray tank. Fill tank, agitate and spray thoroughly to cover foliage and fruit for best results.
