PEARS - To prevent scald.

Wrap pears within one week of post-harvest. Wraps treated with a maximum of 1,000 ppm ethoxyquin may be used on pears that have either been sprayed or drenched once with ethoxyquin. Application of ethoxyquin by line spraying must not exceed a total of 1,700 ppm or 1,000 ppm when applied as a drench. Do not re-use fruit wrap.

This label for Pear Wrap Treated with Ethoxyquin and Copper expires and must not be distributed or used in accordance with this SLN registration after December 31, 2010.
